

## First Bible study /reading

It does not follow the books of the Bible in the order they are commonly written in our Bibles, and it does not follow any chronology of bible history. Neither does it prescribe "a little of the Old Testament and a little of the New Testament" as many often suggest. This is not to say that any of the above methods are wrong or of little value. But this one is different.

The word of God is a treasure and a jewel, it is a living and active thing that lights darkness, corrects errors, executes true justice, heals blindness, and many more things. The word of God is timeless - that is - Eternal, it is not chronological, although it has come to us through history. The history described in the Bible is accurate, but the Bible is birthed and given from Spirit of God.

Georgiann's study begins by introducing us to the true Nature and character of God, and it begins in the first week to show us the surety of our salvation in the Lord Jesus Christ. Since we must always operate by faith in the Kingdom of God, it is of primary importance that we are sure of these things first.

On average, reading time is only 15-20 minutes a day.

There is one day every week that has no assigned reading. This does not mean that you should not read that day. You can read any piece of scripture you want. Be free to take in as little or as much as you like on the seventh day. Consider it as a "Sabbath" - a day to remind us all of the completion and "REST" that is still ahead prepared for us. It is like a wedding day, a day set aside for intimacy and union with our Lord.
